Section 2: The Board hereby delegates to the General Manager the authority to execute contracts, as defined in CRW's Local Contract Review Board Rules, up to the total annual amount of \$75,000.00 for a duration no longer than three years.

Section 3. The Board hereby delegates to the General Manager the authority to execute Public Improvement Contracts, as defined in CRW's Local Contract Review Board Rules, up to the amount of \$100,000.

ANALYSIS

The District is required to operate the municipal water utility. The General Manager has been given responsibility for the procurement of all goods and services. Contracts (and their payments) over the General Manager authority of \$75,000 must be approved by the Board.

Vendor payments for the past year, current contracts, and the BN 2023-2025 adopted budget were reviewed for possible vendor payments that will exceed \$75,000 during FY 2023-24.

BACKGROUND

CRW Board Policies - Section 4.7 Insurance Agent of Record (B) The agent will be designated by the Board for a period to be determined by the Board with an annual review of the type and quality of service and the insurance program recommended by such agent.

In 2018 staff conducted an RFP process to select an Insurance Agent of Record for the District. Two responses were received and after evaluation, WHA, Inc. was selected and the Board approved WHA, Inc. as the Insurance Agent of Record. The existing contract with WHA, Inc. will expire August 31, 2023.

The Local Contract Review Board Rule -130-001 Insurance Agent of Record and Insurance Contracts

130-010

It is recommended that the market period served by an agent of record not exceed three years. If sufficient justification exists, the PCO may continue with an agent of record for consecutive terms of service, provided the PCO conducts a review of the services performed by the agent of record and determines that continuation of service is justified. Agents may serve for more than one appointment period. Agents must qualify for appointment prior to each period as if each appointment period were the first.

130-011 All insurance contracts, not including insurance agent of record contracts as covered above, must be approved by the Board.

WHA has been working with CRW to implement new programs and with the workman's compensation transition. The services provided by WHA have been valuable and responsive to the needs of CRW.

ANALYSIS

CRW staff are requesting that the Board approve a one-year extension to allow time to complete transition activities that are currently underway and to recognize the current time limitations of CRW staff due to some key unfilled position. The extension is justified by the circumstances, including ongoing programs with WHA and decreased management capacity due to unfilled senior management positions.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff is recommending that the Board approve a one-year contract extension with WHA.

BACKGROUND

Under Section 3.1 of the Employment Agreement between CRW and Todd Heidgerken, the General Manager's base salary is adjusted annually for a cost-of-living increase. The agreement establishes a minimum cost-of-living adjustment of 2% of the gross annual salary. The Board also has the discretion, under Section 3.1 of the agreement, to provide a greater cost-of-living increase beyond the 2% minimum. If approved, the proposed additional 2% increase would be applied in the next payroll cycle (July 22, 2023).

3.1 <u>Base Salary</u>. The General Manager's current salary is \$165,630.75 per year. Effective July 1, 2021, CRW shall pay General Manager a gross annual salary of \$173,913.00 per annum, minus applicable local, state and federal tax withholdings and other withholdings that General Manager has authorized, payable at least monthly in accordance with CRW's payroll practices in effect from time to time. Effective on July 1, 2022, and annually every July 1 during the term of this Agreement, the General Manager will receive a "cost of living" increase of two percent (2%) of his gross annual salary, or such greater amount as the Board of Commissioners may in its discretion establish. The parties mutually agree to review the General Manager's salary stated herein not less than once every other year in comparison to reasonably comparable water districts in the Portland metropolitan area. The parties shall then determine whether an adjustment to the General Manager's salary is appropriate.

A. Management Report

1. Communications:

Monthly Report – The monthly report will be provided to the Board separately and posted on the CRW Website.

2. One Water System Identification Number – Since Clackamas River Water resulted from the merger of two water systems, the state has previously determined that we needed to continue to have two water system identification numbers until we were able to provide water from the CRW water treatment plant to customers south of the river. Having two water system numbers requires a fair amount of duplication in reporting and planning.

CRW now has that ability to serve a portion of our customers south of the river. The state now appears more amenable to CRW being considered under one system identification number. Staff is preparing to provide a formal request to the state to consider allowing us to operate under one water system identification number.

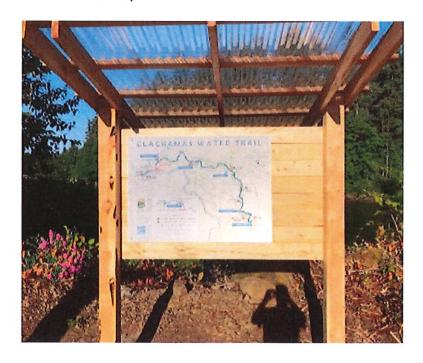
3. Happy New "Fiscal" Year – July 1 signifies the start of the new fiscal year at CRW. This means that we will be operating under the newly adopted budget. The 2023-2025 budget is at the printer and will be distributed to the Board Members during the July 20th Board meeting. The Citizen Budget Committee Members will receive copies of the budget as well. The adopted budget along with the updated fees and charges documents will also be posted on the CRW website. Many thanks to the finance staff who have been focused on preparing for the 2024 fiscal year and working on activities to close out the 2023 fiscal year.

4. New "Clackamas River Water Trail" Signage at Riverside Park – The Clackamas River is a popular recreation spot, especially in the summer. Recently, a collaboration of local agencies and non-profits assembled the "Clackamas Water Trail" website (https://clackamaswatertrail.org/) to assist those in both learning about the Clackamas River and planning their next adventure. In addition to the website, the group plans to use kiosks to share information. The first outdoor map sign and kiosk was installed at Riverside Park on June 25th (shown below).

Built with Northwest native and salvaged wood, the sign kiosk is held up with juniper posts and framed with western red and port Orford cedars. The map sign is located in the prime gathering area at the top of the Riverside Park boat launch. It will also allow for Stash the Trash bags and loaner Life Jackets to hang from the structure.

The map design was created by award-winning cartographer, Dave Imus, and the rustic sign kiosk was designed by We Love Clean Rivers and built by volunteers. The thematic map design highlights the same attributes of the online map, and also shows the entirety of the 22-mile Clackamas Water Trail at a large scale and provides perspective for visitors.

While the website can provide real-time data about river conditions, the physical map can reinforce important landmarks for safety and learning (rapid names, bridges, parks, river miles, etc.). It also shows the proximity of the river to Oregon City, Portland (9 miles as the crow flies from map corner), and other towns in the vicinity.



5. Emergency Management Update:

- Continue to work with the County on an update to CRW's Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan which describes hazards like earthquakes, flooding, wildfires, etc. and their impact on CRW assets.
- Continuity of Operations Planning (COOP) will resume in July with conversion to the new state software system, Veoci.
- CRW will be hosting the Regional Water Providers Consortium (RWPC) water treatment trailer exercise/drill in September at Riverside Park, planning is beginning for this regional activity.
- CRW participated in a communications drill with Clackamas County to test our UHF radio connection with them as well as our satellite phones at our 3 main locations. The radio exercise was successful, however, the satellite phone system had issues overall (not just on CRW's phones). The county will be working with us to resolve this issue.

6. Safety Update:

- Staff is working on revision of CRW's respiratory protection program and plan. New equipment ordered and training planned for July 5 for System Operations and Water Resources.
- Hearing conservation measurements will be conducted in July and August.
- Starting in July, Jeff Griffin from WHA will be facilitating our safety committee to support Beth's revised portfolio of duties. This will be for the next 12 months.

7. Security Update

- Continued work to stabilize camera feeds with new vendor.
- Supply chain impacts delayed manual lock conversion. Project delayed until at least August 2023.
- Digital security improvements for access control will be paused until camera feeds are stabilized.

8. Looking Ahead:

- The agenda setting meeting for the August Board meeting will be held on Thursday, July 27 at 9am
- The CRW Regular August Board Meeting will be held on Thursday, August 10 at 6pm

Regulatory

All 73 samples collected and analyzed for the June monitoring period showed no presence of coliform/*E. coli* bacteria.

Cyanotoxin Testing

Microcystin and Cylindrospermopsin sampling of our raw water began in May and occurs every two weeks for compliance.

No cyanotoxins have been detected in our raw water.

PGE did see a suspected bloom in the North Fork Reservoir near the dam on Monday July 3rd. Flowcam analysis of their sample that day showed no signs of a harmful algal bloom. An extra cyantotoxin sampling event let us know by July 5th that the reservoir sample <u>and our raw water</u> did not contain detectable amounts of any of the four cyantoxins.

Non-Regulatory

General water quality parameters (pH, temperature, chlorine, TDS, hardness, alkalinity) were collected throughout the distribution system at 16 locations in the North and South systems.

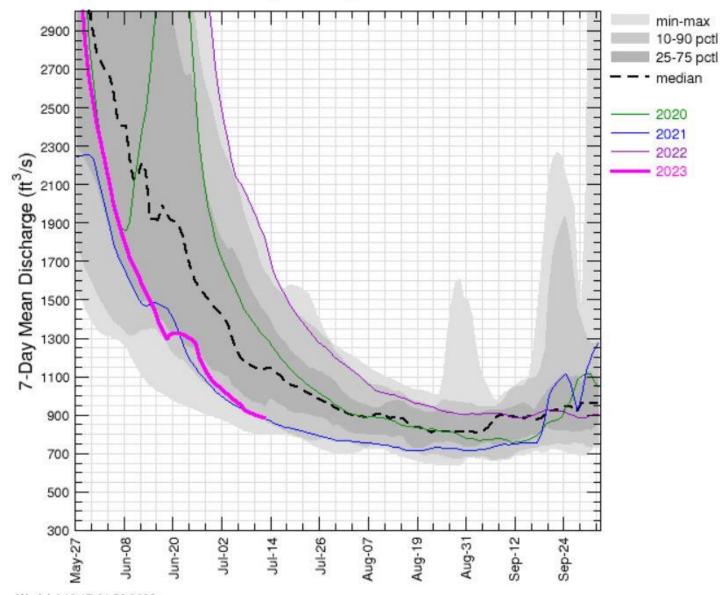
Weekly algae monitoring is occurring at 3 locations in the North Fork Reservoir and CRW's intakes. This work includes species monitoring with the FlowCAM and nutrient analysis.

Monthly watershed sampling was conducted at 4 long-term sampling locations for total organic carbon, nutrients (nitrate/nitrite, total phosphorus, orthophosphate, etc), coliform density, pH, dissolved oxygen, TDS, temperature, and volatile organic carbon compounds (VOCs, 21 regulated for drinking water, 36 unregulated).

- The current Clackamas River 7-day average steamflow is 74% of normal (median).
- June **precipitation in the Clackamas basin was 43% of normal.** Precipitation since the beginning of the water year (October 1 July 11) has been 78% of normal.
- The three-month outlook (Jul-Sep) from the NOAA Climate Prediction Center calls for an likely chance of above normal temperatures, and near-normal precipitation for most of Oregon.
