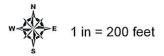

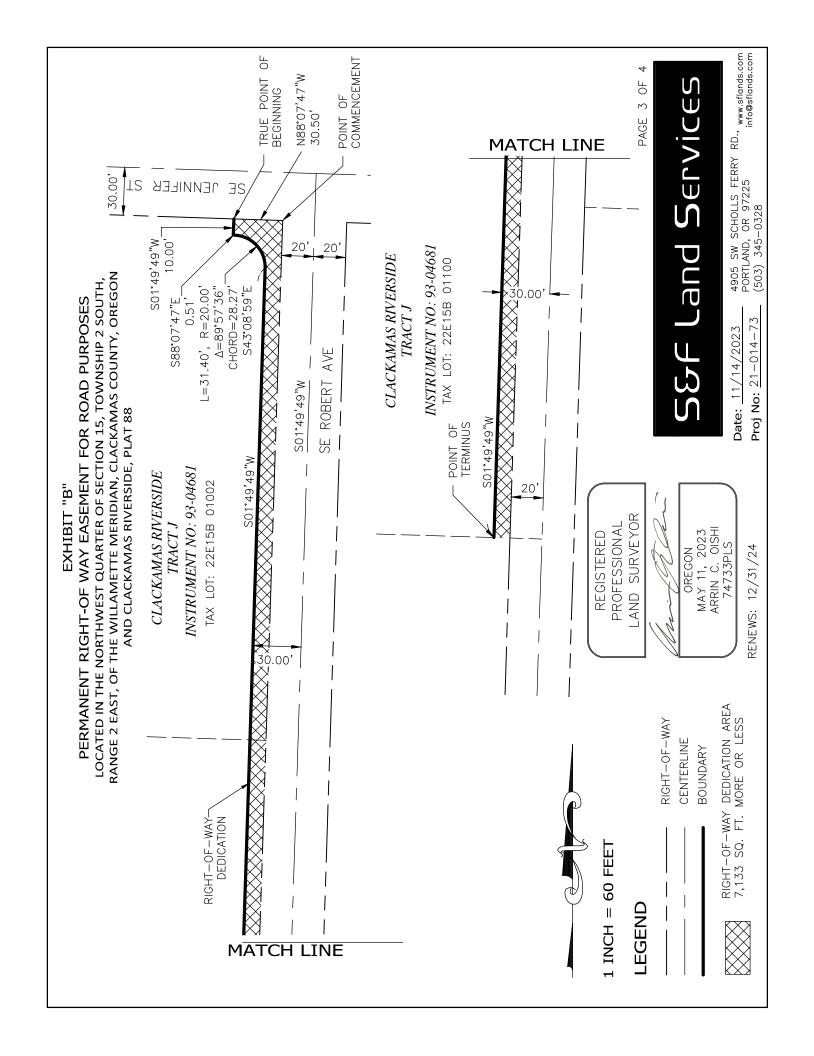

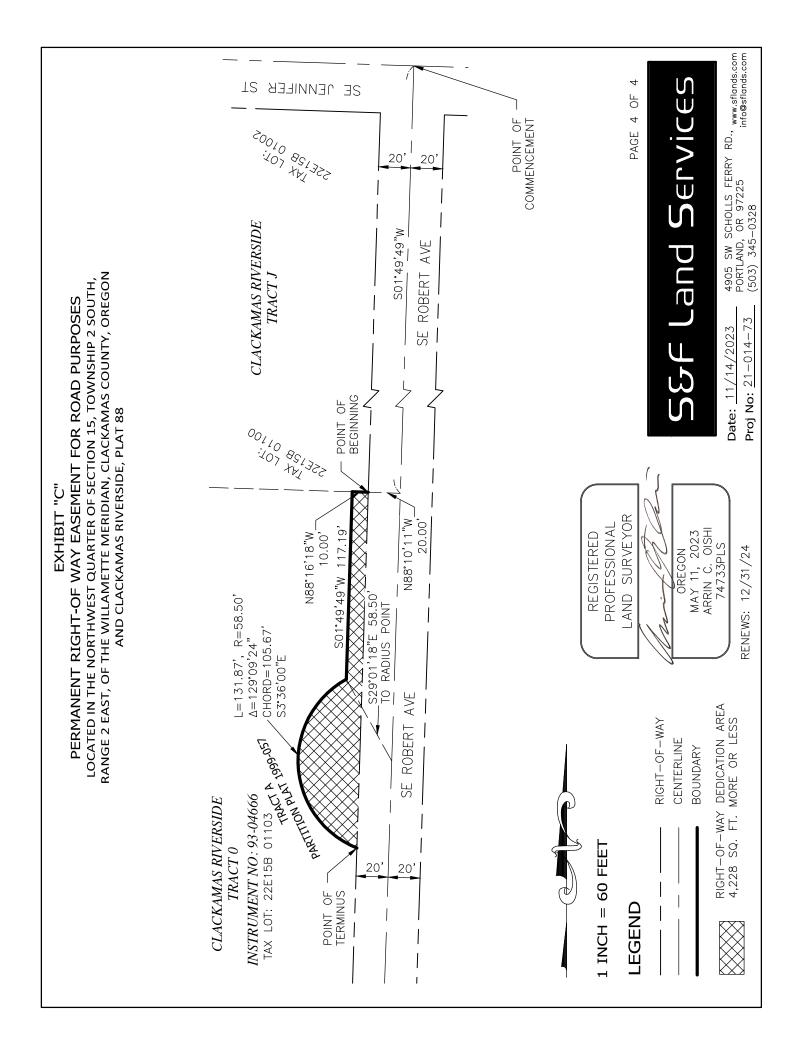

Agenda Summary

BACKGROUND

The WTP Concrete Repairs and Seismic Bracing project was included in the adopted 2023-2025 Biennial Budget.

The project is an aging infrastructure improvement and is listed in the WTP Facility Master Plan. A structural study was completed by RH2 Engineering in 2023, which identified a number of concrete repairs and non-structural bracing for equipment and other features at the treatment plant. To accommodate this work, RH2 identified core improvements that would be best completed during a plant shutdown. While this work does not include all of the tasks identified in the study, it optimizes the scope by targeting concrete repairs and bracing that can be completed during the upcoming plant shutdown required by the separate filter valves replacement project. Other work identified in the RH2 structural study will be addressed at a later time, as schedules and project budget allow.

ANALYSIS

Emery and Sons Construction Group, the contractor selected for this project, was vetted through our qualification based on-call selection process and is listed as one of our on-call contractors. The scope exceeds the amount approved in the on-call contract; therefore, the work will be awarded in a separate contract. RH2 Engineering also recommended Emery and Sons for this type of specialty work, as a contractor with extensive experience and history of successful similar projects.

This procurement is exempt from the competitive solicitation requirements of the Local Contract Review Board Rules, as determined from Section 110-012.f - Public Contract Exceptions and Exemptions; Special Procurements, which states the exemption for "Distribution and Treatment system related Equipment, Repair, Maintenance and Overhaul..."

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that a construction contract be awarded to Emery and Sons Construction Group Not to Exceed \$400,000 for the WTP Concrete Repairs and Seismic Bracing project.

A. Management Report

1. Communications:

Monthly Report – The monthly report will be provided to the Board separately and posted on the CRW Website.

- 2. Water Treatment Plant Valve Project and Temporary Shutdown Final testing of the interties with North Clackamas County Water Commission (NCCWC) and South Fork Water Board (SFWB) was completed on March 6. This was the final step in preparing for the valve project and temporary plant shutdown. Given the results of the test we are planning to proceed with the project. The project will include a shutdown of the CRW water treatment plant for the period of March 20 to May 9. The contract with Emery and Son's to complete the valve work has been signed. All the materials are in the Portland area and will be staged onsite at CRW. We are using the temporary shutdown period to also perform a variety of maintenance tasks on the water treatment plant that are easier to accomplish while the water treatment plant is out of service. The cooperation of our partners at the NCCWC (including staff from Sunrise Water Authority and Oak Lodge Water Services) and SFWB has been greatly appreciated in making this project happen.
- 3. Regional Water Providers Consortium (RWPC) Technical Committee The March 6 meeting of the RWPC Technical Committee focused on the most recent winter storm event and cybersecurity. Water utilities had a chance to share impacts and lessons learned from the winter storm event. CRW was fortunate to experience limited impacts from the storm, these impacts were resolved by staff in a timely manner. The remainder of the meeting was to receive reports from RWPC staff on the status of projects.
- 4. Riverside Park- Clackamas Little League will hold their opening day ceremonies and game on April 6 at the fields at Riverside Park. Staff and Commissioners have been invited to attend the ceremonies.

- 5. Emergency Management Update Work on CRWP (Clackamas River Water Providers) planning for emergency drinking water planning continues. CRW will be present at a workshop in March to determine the manner in which documentation will occur for this critical community mission in coordination with Clackamas County. Also, we are in the discussion on how water providers will be part of the statewide/county exercise of a Cascadia Subduction Zone response in October 2024. Exercise objectives for the county are:
 - Emergency communications (not email or cell), likely satellite radio.
 - Emergency Coordination Center (EOC) functions at the county: How will water providers fit into that EOC.
 - Emergency Situational Status Reporting and Resource Ordering: How
 will water providers submit data on emergency drinking water response,
 how will it be analyzed, reported back out as a sector, and practicing
 submitting resource orders for water specific surge staffing, equipment,
 etc. to support response in the first 30 days post event.
- 6. Safety Update The Safety program continues to progress with PPE (Personal Protective Equipment) being a focus of February's training. CPR/First Aid training course was held in February, 16 staff got their American Heart Association certification. March will provide SysOps and Water Resources Staff with the confined space rescue training to support the plant shut down activities.

The District took time at an all staff meeting to recognize the second year of ZERO reportable accidents at CRW! This is a significant achievement since it is important that all our staff return home every night safely. In addition, this is directly related to supporting our Strategic Goal #2 of providing a safe environment for our employees. And finally, this also helps with expenses such as workman's compensation premiums, not having to spend resources on claims (both time and money).

7. **Security Update-** Security access and alarm systems installation continue with troubleshooting and final installations at pump stations. The management team will be discussing the approach to vendor and contractor badge access. Planning to issue a new security policy draft by the end of March.

Regulatory

All 73 samples collected and analyzed for the February monitoring period showed no presence of coliform/E. coli bacteria.

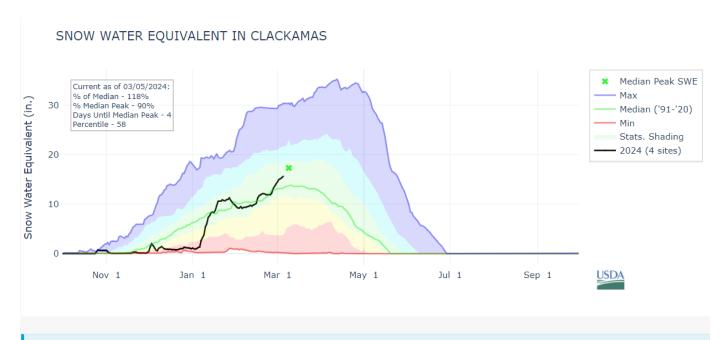
In February we began sampling for the Fifth Unregulated Contaminant Monitoring Rule (UCMR5) in both our North and South systems. Sampling will occur quarterly during the calendar year 2024 and focuses on unregulated PFAS compounds. There were none detected in the February samples.

Non-Regulatory

General water quality parameters (pH, temperature, chlorine, TDS, hardness, alkalinity) were collected throughout the distribution system at 19 locations in the North and South systems.

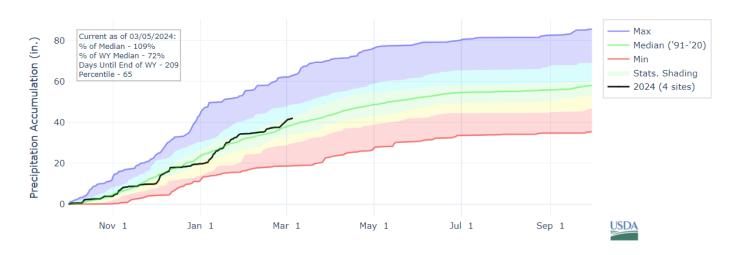
Monthly watershed sampling was conducted at 4 long-term sampling locations for total organic carbon, nutrients (nitrate/nitrite, total phosphorus, orthophosphate, etc), VOCs (Volatile Organic Chemicals), coliform density, pH, dissolved oxygen, TDS, and temperature.

- As of March 05, 2024, the Willamette basin snowpack was 118% of median.
- February **precipitation in the Clackamas basin was 117% of normal.** Precipitation since the beginning of the water year (October 1 March 4) has been 109% of normal.
- The three-month outlook (Mar-May) from the NOAA Climate Prediction Center shows a high likelihood of above normal temperatures for Oregon, and a slightly elevated chance of below normal precipitation.
